HISTORICAL MARKERS PRESERVE & PROMOTE LOCAL HISTORY

Did you know that this Kathleen School was built in 1928? Did you know that this school was the first in the Kathleen Area to offer a 12th grade education? Did you know that the first graduating class was in 1932, comprised of six students? Do you know their names?

Local history is the first history to be lost, but through the efforts of many individuals and organizations like the Kathleen Area Historical Society and the Polk County Historical Commission (PCHC), local history is preserved and promoted.

The PCHC offers a Historical Marker Program to educate, recognize and encourage the preservation of local history with topics like persons, events, institutions, buildings, ethnic groups, churches, sites, cemeteries, and communities. There are currently 26 PCHC markers in Polk County, including the marker pictured which was installed in 2017 on the grounds of Bethel Baptist Church in the Socrum community.

In cooperation with the Polk County School Board, the *Friends of Kathleen School* fundraising initiative seeks to sponsor

placement of a historical marker on school grounds to preserve and promote the history of Kathleen School. The process requires submission of a carefully researched and documented application to the PCHC for review and approval. Once approved, the marker is fabricated and installed. The cost of these very attractive 42" x 30" markers is approximately \$2,800. A public dedication and unveiling ceremony is then scheduled to celebrate the preservation of history
